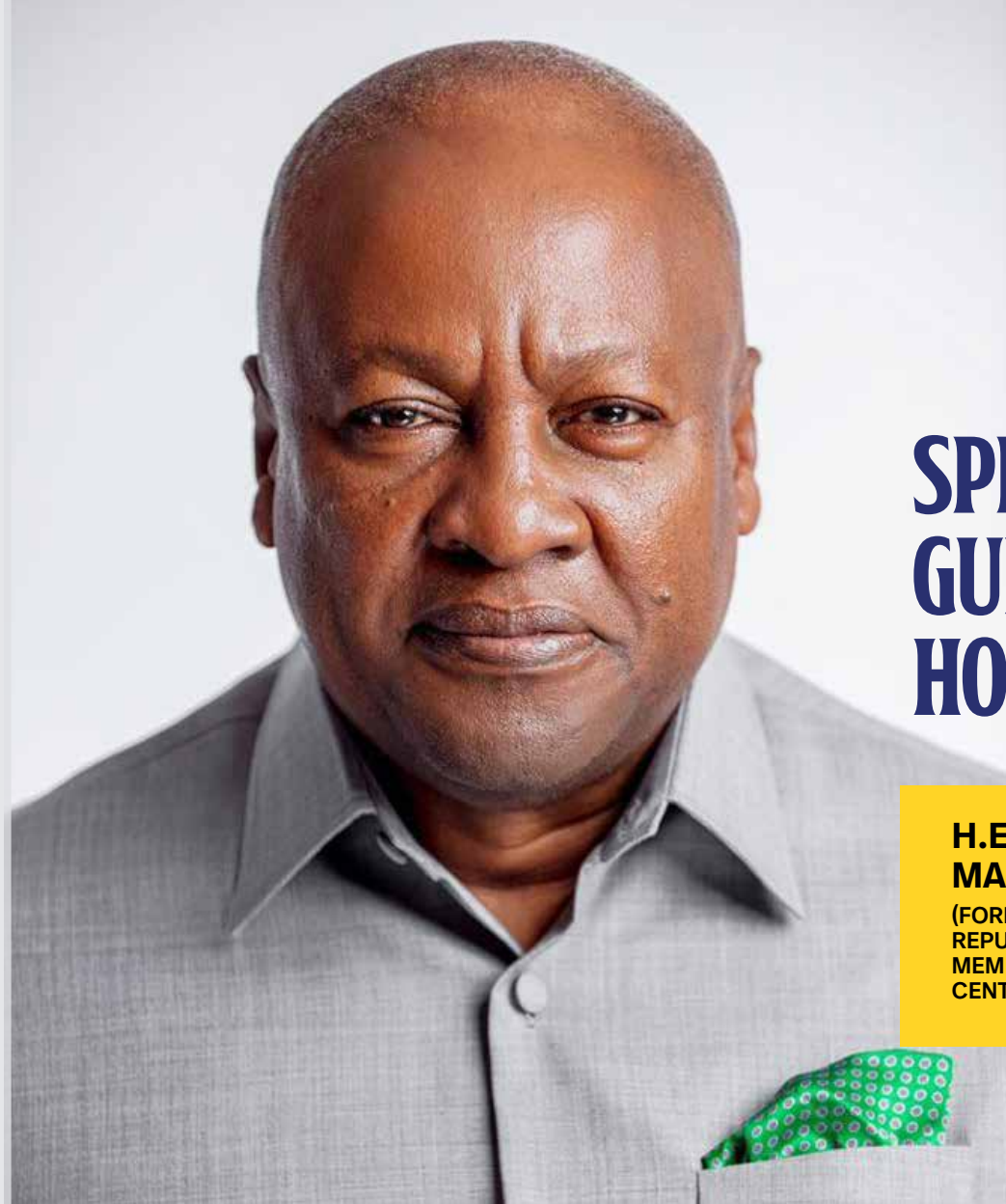

ASSEMBLIES OF GOD

WORLDWIDE & GHANA

Formed in the midst of the emerging worldwide Pentecostal revival, the Assemblies of God was born out of the Azusa Street revival in the USA in 1914. It quickly took root in other countries and formed indigenous national organizations. The Assemblies of God (A/G) worldwide is known as the World Assemblies of God Fellowship.

Assemblies of God (A/G), is dotted in more than 212 countries in the world. Currently, Assemblies of God has more than 70 million members worldwide, about 18 million members in Africa, and almost 700,000 members in Ghana.

Assemblies of God has been in Africa for about 100 years. It came to Ghana from Burkina Faso through American Missionaries. It was established in 1931 in Yendi (Northern Ghana), after the Missionaries had been invited by the then Yaa-Na, King of Dagbon. It is a member of the Worldwide Fellowship of Assemblies of God.

From Yendi, A/G - Ghana started spreading down to mid-Ghana and then to the Southern parts of Ghana. Assemblies of God is first in many things here in Ghana – the first foreign Pentecostal body to work in Ghana, the first Pentecostal church to put up a theological (Bible School) institute; the first Pentecostal church to use social action to minister to people; and the first Pentecostal church to put up clinics in Ghana. Besides, A/G - Ghana has 350 schools across the country (basic,

secondary, and tertiary). The church in Ghana runs 24 administrative regions and 215 districts; supervises about 6,000 churches and 3,800 pastors.

The church since 1931, has been under the leadership of the following noblemen:

- Rev. Elijah J. Namyela-Panka (first Indigenous General Superintendent 1970-1986)

- Rev. Moses S. Sumaila (2009-2010)
- Rev. Prof. Paul Frimpong-Manso (2010-2022)
- Rev. Dr. Stephen Wengam (2022 - date)

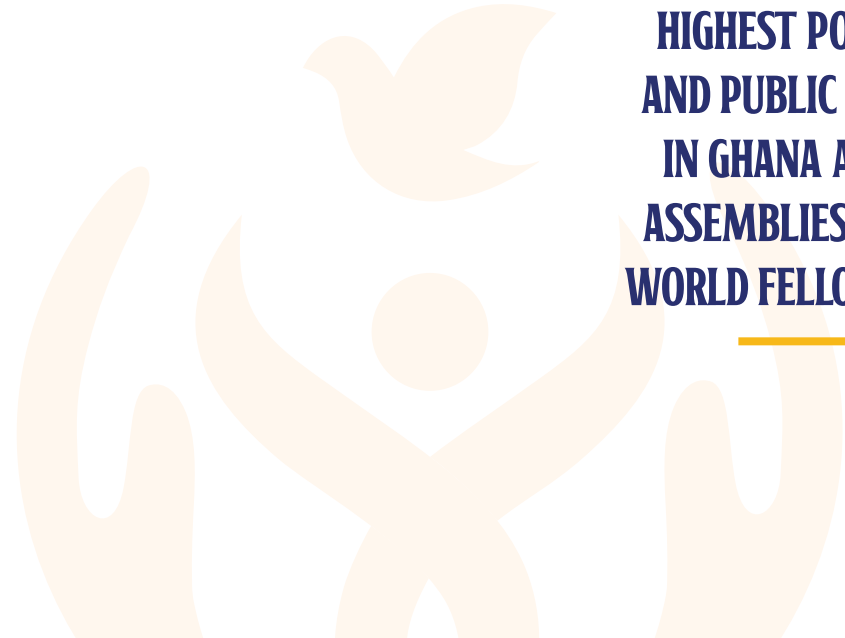
A former assistant General Superintendent of Assemblies of God Ghana, the late Rev. Gyan Fosu moved the idea of the formation of the Ghana Pentecostal and Charismatic Council - the largest Church Council in Ghana in terms of population and denomination members.

Assemblies of God is the first Pentecostal church in Ghana to have had some of its members rise to the highest political and public service in Ghana and the Assemblies of God world fellowship.

of Assemblies of God

These are non-negotiable tenets of faith that all Assemblies of God churches adhere to:

01

WE BELIEVE...

The Scriptures are Inspired by God and declare His design and plan for mankind.

02

WE BELIEVE...

There is only One True God –revealed in three persons...Father, Son, and Holy Spirit (commonly known as the Trinity).

03

WE BELIEVE...

In the Deity of the Lord Jesus Christ. As God's son Jesus was both human and divine.

04

WE BELIEVE...

Though originally good, **Man Willingly Fell to Sin** – ushering evil and death, both physical and spiritual, into the world.

05

WE BELIEVE...

Every Person Can Have Restored Fellowship with God Through 'Salvation' (trusting Christ, through faith and repentance, to be our personal Savior). [1 of 4 cardinal doctrines of the A/G]

06

WE BELIEVE...

and practice two ordinances -
(1) **Water Baptism** by Immersion after repenting of one's sins and receiving Christ's gift of salvation, and
(2) **Holy Communion** (the Lord's Supper) as a symbolic remembrance of Christ's suffering and death for our salvation.

07

WE BELIEVE...

the Baptism in the Holy Spirit is a Special Experience Following Salvation that empowers believers for witnessing and effective service, just as it did in New Testament times. [1 of 4 cardinal doctrines of the A/G]

08

WE BELIEVE...

The Initial Physical Evidence of the Baptism in the Holy Spirit is 'Speaking in Tongues,' as experienced on the Day of Pentecost and referenced throughout Acts and the Epistles.

09

WE BELIEVE...

Sanctification Initially Occurs at Salvation and is not only a declaration that a believer is holy, but also a progressive lifelong process of separating from evil as believers continually draw closer to God and become more Christlike.

WE BELIEVE...

The Church has a Mission to seek and save all who are lost in sin. We believe 'the Church' is the Body of Christ and consists of the people who, throughout time, have accepted God's offer of redemption (regardless of religious denomination) through the sacrificial death of His son Jesus Christ.

Rev. Dr. Stephen Y. Wengam is an ordained minister of the Assemblies of God, Ghana, and hails from Paknatik in the Bunkpurugu-Nakpanduri district in the northern region of Ghana.

ACADEMIC CREDENTIALS

He holds a Diploma in Theology from the Assemblies of God Theological Seminary, North East campus, Kumbungu, a BSc. Admin(Marketingoption)fromtheUniversity of Ghana, a certificate in Corporate Governance from Ghana Institute of Management and Public Administration (GIMPA), a Master of Theology Degree from the International Theological Seminary, U.S.A., and a Diploma in Christian Clinical Counselling from same.

He was awarded an honorary Doctorate Degree by the Pan African Clergy Council.

HUMBLE ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Senior Resident Pastor of Citi 97.3FM, a privately owned radio station in Accra, up until 2022. He hosted the programme, “This Is Your Day”, a family morning devotion programme that runs from Monday to Saturday, from 4:00 a.m. to 6:00 am.

Rev. Wengam is the immediate past Chairman of the Ghana Prisons Service Council. He was appointed by H.E. John Dramani Mahama, during his tenure as President of the Republic of Ghana. Through the visionary leadership of Rev. Wengam, the Sixth Prisons Council launched a Ten-Year Strategic Plan and a Self-Help Project

christened “Project Efiase,” where they solicited public and private sector support to transform Ghana Prisons into centers of excellence.

He also served as a member of the Fifth Prisons Council from 2009-2013. Rev. Wengam serves as a member of the Citi Fm Foundation Board.

As the West Africa Executive Coordinator of Global Leadership Training, U.S.A, he has coordinated conferences for civic, corporate, political, religious, and emerging leaders since 2008. He is highly regarded as a spiritual mentor and coach to political, civic, and corporate leaders, and is the author of the bestselling book, 365 Prayer Missiles.

Under his visionary leadership and as lead pastor of Cedar Mountain, East Legon, the church was adjudged Global Council Assemblies of God USA 2022.



He has travelled wide and visited countries in Asia, Europe, North and South America, the Middle East, and Africa, to preach, and in some instances, perform special assignments.

Rev. Godwin Tito Agyei (aka Kwadwo Agyei) was born on 30th December 1963 to the late Opanin Yaw Korang Manu and late Madam Grace Adwoa Pokuaa. He hails from Bamang near Bonwire in the Mampong District of the Ashanti Region.

Rev. Tito Agyei got converted quite early in life and was baptized in 1980 by Rev Nicholas Opuni of the Lighthouse(Central) Assembly of God church in Kumasi.

MINISTRY

Pastor Tito, as he is affectionately called, got enrolled at the defunct Mid-Ghana Bible School in 1989 and completed in 1991 with a Diploma in Biblical studies. Rev Ransford Obeng was his pastor during his Bible school days.

Rev. Tito Agyei was posted to New Life Assembly of God in Akrokerri in the Adansi District from 1992 to 1997. In 1996 he

was invited to be a part-time lecturer at the then Mid-Ghana Bible College and he faithfully discharged this responsibility until the school became defunct.

He was transferred to Grace Assembly of God, Bronkong/Afranko in the Afigya Kwabere South District of the Ashanti Region where he has been made to be at post since February 1997.

Rev. Tito Agyei is married to Rev(Mrs) Gladys Agyei (aka Gladys Ofori) since 13th March 1993 and they have four adult children between them and two grandchildren.

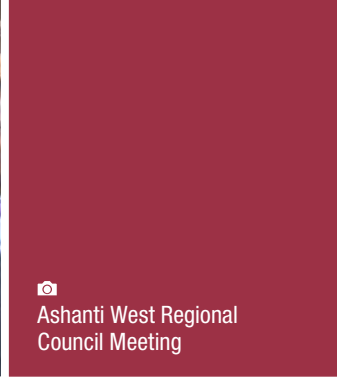

REV. DR. ERNEST BIRIKORANG

Rev. Dr. Ernest Birikorang was born to Chief Superintendent George Andrew Birikorang and Mrs. Rose Fokuo Birikorang at Asante Mampong in the Ashanti Region of Ghana.

EDUCATION

He pursued his secondary education at Nsaba Presbyterian Secondary School and Mfantipim School from 1977. After, he continued with the West Africa Secondary School for the “A” level, while pursuing a Diploma in Business Studies at Accra Polytechnic in 1983. He then went on to Southern Ghana Bible Institute, now called, Assemblies of God Theological Seminary (AGTS) to pursue a Diploma in Theology in 1989. He completed his Bachelor of Theology at Assemblies of God Bible College in 2000. He also pursued a Master in Theology at

the International Theological Seminary in 2001 and a Master of Philosophy at the University of Cape Coast in 2010. In 2017, he completed his Doctor of Philosophy Degree at Larette Universities.

CALL TO MINISTRY

He responded to the call to Ministry in 1985. After acquiring educational and practical experience in ministry, Rev. Ernest Birikorang was ordained as a Reverend Minister of the Assemblies of God Church in 1996.

WORK EXPERIENCE

Rev. Dr. Ernest Birikorang started secular work with the Ghana Police Service at the Budget Office, National Headquarters, where he served his national service from 1985. He also worked at Blessed Redemption Theological College from 1991 to 1994. He lectured in various periods at Glory Leadership Institute, World Miracle Ministry College, and All the Gospel Theological College, all in the Greater Accra Region. He has been an adjunct lecturer at the Assemblies of God Theological Seminary from 2002 till date.

RADIO AND TELEVISION AND OTHER MINISTRIES

Rev. Dr. Ernest Birikorang is a voice on radio and television. He hosts a weekly biblical exposition session on Sunny FM (A Christian radio station in Ghana) and also on

AGTV (Assemblies of God Ghana's official television station). Both programmes are dubbed "Moment of Truth". He is also the Board Chairman of Elrano Projects and Consult, a business development and solution company with a specialty in real estate, marine services, and oil and gas.
